BROWN BEAR	1x1 10 Days	\$ 14,500
Brown bear hunt: Expectation – 9’ bear and 80% plus success rate with Alaska Master Guide. Spring and fall hunts. Spring hunt is conducted by snow mobile from a fishing lodge. Fall hunt is spot and stalk from traditional tented camp located in the exclusive guide area.		
ALASKA MOOSE	1x1 10 Days	\$ 11,500 – \$ 12,500
Alaska Yukon Moose hunt: Expectations – average spreads are approximately 58” with area producing the #6 SCI bull, and 100% shooting opportunity with two experienced operators in the Alaska Range. Walking hunt or track vehicle hunts are available. Both hunts are based from comfortable tent camps with great food.		
DALL SHEEP	1x1 10 Days	\$ 14,500
Dall Sheep hunt: Expectations – 80 to 90% success rate. This is a true wilderness hunt in the extreme NE corner of Alaska’s Brooks Range. A hunt in the Brooks Range is not as physically demanding as other sheep hunts, but the numbers and quality of sheep are excellent and improving. Legal Rams = full curl. This hunt can be combined with grizzly bear, moose, and caribou at an additional cost.		
COASTAL BLACK BEAR	2x1 5 Days	\$ 7,500
This will be 100% shooting opportunity at large bears where you will see upwards of 50 plus bears on the Prince William Sound. These hunts are conducted both spring & fall from our new 80’ Alaskan Harvest Luxury Yacht. During the spring you will hunt cruising the coast looking for rutting bears which is very limited physical adventure. Fall hunts will involve spot and stalking them on the salmon flooded streams.		
COASTAL BROWN BEAR	1X1 10 Days	\$ 20,500
Nearly 80% success rate on these hunts in spring or fall. Spring and fall hunts are conducted out of our new 80’ Alaskan Harvest Luxury Yacht where you will take a 16’ aluminum boat to shore hunting bears. Bears will normally run 8.5’-10’ squared.		
ROCKY MOUNTAIN GOAT	1X1 7 Days	\$ 14,500
These Mt. Goat hunts are done in the late season, which is generally the last week of October to the end of November when they are accessible and in rut. This part of the year the hair is normally extremely long which always makes for a great mount. The snow and rain pushes them down to these lower altitudes where the hunting is much easier. We run virtually 100% ON THESE HUNTS and average 9” goats.		
ALSO AVAILABLE: Goat hunts on draw basis, additional Sheep and Grizzly hunts in the Brooks Range, other boat based Brown and Black Bear hunts, and drop-off DIY hunts for Sitka Blacktail Deer.
