



GENERAL INFORMATION

Home to some of the finest wildlife habitat in Africa, Tanzania is a premier safari destination. Large and remote wilderness areas combined with an abundance and variety of wildlife provide a setting conducive to classic tented camp safaris.

HUNTING AREAS

Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. offers hunting safaris throughout Tanzania.

In Masailand we conduct our hunting safaris from two excellent areas, namely Lolkisale Game Control Area and Masai Open Area (West), also known as Loibor Serrit. These areas are each well known for producing quality trophies. The areas, characterized by expansive plains dotted with acacia thickets, Baobab trees, large rocky outcrops and rugged ravines, provide excellent habitat for Lion, Leopard, Cape Buffalo and many antelope species unique to East Africa such as Lesser Kudu, Fringe Eared Oryx and Grants Gazelle. Other major antelope trophies are East African Eland and East African Greater Kudu.

The Selous Game Reserve block, LU-5 is very remote and is located on the Luwegu River in the Southwestern portion of the Reserve. It is a particularly scenic and diverse area having regions of thick forest, Miombo woodlands, open grass plains and rolling hills. Our campsite has an expansive view of the Luwegu River. LU-5 offers Elephant, Lion, Leopard, Buffalo, Crocodile and Hippo. Also present are the major antelope species of Eland, Greater Kudu, Sable and Nyasaland Wildebeest.

Located close to the Equator, Tanzania enjoys a comfortable climate. Temperatures typically range in the 60's to 80's from early mornings to evenings.

CAMPS

Traditional, comfortable tented safari camps are established in scenic locals in each area. Each tent has en suite bathroom facilities. A centrally located dining area is where all meals are served and daily adventures relived. Camps are equipped with refrigerator/freezers, generators, appropriate lighting and VHF radios for daily contact with our head office. Cuisine is of a high standard with fresh fruits, vegetables, game meats and wild fowl being the standard fare. Bottled water, soft drinks, beer, wine and spirits are all readily available.

HUNTING REGULATIONS

- The hunting season begins on July 1 and ends on December 31.
- No animal may be shot from, chased or driven by vehicle.
- Female, young or immature animals may not be hunted.
- Automatic weapons and handguns are strictly prohibited.
- All hunting clients and non-hunting observers must register their names and full particulars before proceeding to the hunting area. This information will be collected prior to the beginning of the safari in the questionnaire provided upon confirmation of the safari.

FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION

Each hunting client may import three rifles and one shotgun into Tanzania. Most shooting for non-dangerous game is best done with a medium rifle of .270 to .338 caliber.

For medium rifles the ammunition should be loaded with premium soft nose bullets. Some good examples of this bullet type are Barnes Triple Shock X-Bullet, Trophy Bonded Bear Claw and Swift A-Frame. The medium rifle should be sighted in to strike zero at 200 yards.

The minimum caliber for dangerous game is .375. Other popular calibers for dangerous game are the various .416s and .458s and the .470 Nitro Express. For the heavy rifle you should bring the heaviest weight of bullet available for the caliber also loaded with premium soft nose bullets of the type specified above. Your heavy rifle should be sighted in to strike zero at 100 yards.

CITIES PERMITS

CITIES permits are required for the importation of Leopard and Elephant trophies into the United States from Tanzania. These permits are available through the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and should be applied for prior to your safari. A copy of the CITIES permit should be brought with you to Tanzania and the original left with your taxidermist or shipping broker.

CLOTHING

Hunting clothes should be comfortable, quiet and sturdy. Cotton fabrics in dark greens and browns are best. Mornings and evenings can be quite cool, therefore a light or medium weight jacket and a sweater are recommended. Lightweight rain gear should be included for November/December safaris. Laundry is done in camp daily.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Tanzania is a malarial area and precautions should be taken. Please check with your physician or local health authority for details of health regulations and immunization requirements. We provide basic medical kits in all camps; however please ensure that you bring any special medications you may require.

COMMUNICATIONS

Camps are equipped with a VHF radio. Communication is maintained between camps and the head office. For emergencies, messages from your home can be relayed from our United States or Tanzania offices to the hunting camps. A satellite phone is available in each camp.

AIR CHARTERS

No air charter is required to access Masailand and you will be driven to camp in one of our company vehicles at no additional charge. Air charters are required to access the other hunting areas in Tanzania and a current rate will be provided upon request.

SAFARI RATES INCLUDE:

- The service of an experienced Professional Hunter and vehicle.
- The service of trained staff, including gun bearers, trackers, skimmers, drivers, cook, etc.
- Camp accommodations during safari.
- Food, bottled water, soft drinks & alcoholic beverages in moderation.

- Daily laundry and pressing service.
- Government conservation fees, block fees, hunting permit & taxes. Government rates are subject to increase.
- Trophy handling & dip/crate/pack/export documents and delivery to export broker for shipping.
- Community development and Anti-poaching included in trophy fees.

SAFARI RATES DO NOT INCLUDE:

- Trophy Fees for animals taken or wounded and lost.
- International airline flights or air charter costs.
- Hotel charges before or after the safari.
- Air freight on trophies from Tanzania to final destination.
- Gratuities to Professional Hunter(s) and staff.
- Insurance of any description
- Tanzania entry Visa and airport departure tax.

TROPHY FEES DEPOSIT

You are required to make a refundable deposit towards anticipated trophy fees. This is paid to the USA office 45 days before your safari. We will then reconcile your final bill upon your return from safari.

BOOKING TERMS, CONDITIONS AND RELATED INFORMATION

RESERVATIONS AND CANCELLATIONS

A safari booking is confirmed only upon the receipt of a deposit for the safari. There shall be no binding contract until the deposit is paid and the company acknowledges receipt in writing of the deposit. It shall then be deemed accepted and a confirmed reservation. Failure to remit the safari deposit in full may result in the release of the safari dates and possibly the inability for one to reinstate a reservation. By paying the full deposit, you, the client and Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. are bound under contract for the dates of your safari.

Please refer to the **Terms & Conditions** agreement for the full policy on “Reservations and Payments” and “Cancellations and Refunds”. The reservation deposit confirms arrangements between you, the client, and Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. and constitutes acceptance and confirmation by both parties.

If you, the client, are a “no show”, Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. will treat your reservation as cancelled and all payments made by you will be forfeited.

In the event of a cancellation you are responsible for the full cancellation fee regardless of the amount of deposits you have made to your account.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR

- a) Lost travel time or substitution of facilities.
- b) Itineraries amended after departure.
- c) Circumstances beyond the control of Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. where the company has to make alternative arrangements necessary to ensure the client's safety and/or further participation and enjoyment of the respective safari.
- d) Leaving your safari early.

PAYMENT OF FEES

Prior to your safari Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. or your booking agent will invoice you for Safari Fees and any additional fees for services, which have been requested. The balance of the fees is due no later than 90 days prior to the commencement of your safari. Trophy Fee deposits are due no later than 45 days prior to your safari. At the end of your safari we will provide a final statement detailing trophy fees and any other additional charges. Any outstanding balance due is payable in cash (US dollars) before leaving Tanzania unless prior agreements have been made with your booking agent.

INSURANCE

Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. strongly recommends that you obtain the following types of insurance, all of which are commercially available.

- a) Accidental death and disability.
- b) Emergency medical evacuation.
- c) Loss of personal effects.
- d) Major Medical.
- e) Trip cancellation.

NOTES

- a) Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. acts as a booking agent when requested or necessary for arranging hotels, air charters, photographic operators or other independent agencies providing services. Each of these companies is an independent operation with its own management and is not subject to the control of Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. - c) Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. will strive to ensure that your safari is a success and that all itineraries are organized in advance and that all vehicles are well maintained. However, we make no guarantees that all the animals desired by the client will be collected, nor do we accept any responsibility for weather conditions affecting the safari or delays arising from accidental breakage or damage to hunting vehicles and or air charter availability. Any act of God is out of our control and the company will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury from such occurrences(s).
- d) All Tanzania Government Fees (i.e. trophy fees, block fees, conservation fees) are subject to change without notice. Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. will endeavor to make every effort to advise you of changes of any fees as early as possible. Any new taxes, fees, license or other changes imposed by the Tanzania Government will be the responsibility of the client.
- e) Trophies are handed over to the shipping agent at the airport where the Health & Wildlife Departments inspect and seal the crates after confirming condition and content. At this point Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. ceases to have any control of the trophies and accepts no responsibility for any damage to the crate or its contents. It is the responsibility of the client to obtain insurance to cover any damage or loss to crate contents. Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. will pass on all relevant information in regards to the shipment.
- e) Tanzania Bundu Safaris, Ltd. or its agents will assist or advise you with pertinent information regarding passports, visas and international health requirements. It is however the responsibility of the client to ensure that all necessary documents, certificates and inoculations be obtained.
