Singita Grumeti Reserves forms part of the world-famous migratory route, although year-round the greatest diversity of large mammals in the world can be found. There's an abundance of game including 25 species of large carnivores, 40 species of herbivores

and over 2500 different species of birds (including five endemic species with a high concentration of raptors) that comprise the highest concentration of birds in Africa.

In the lavish Bedouin-style tents, comfort is found in brightly-coloured Maasai blankets, solid wooden furniture, exquisite crystal, silverware, plush rugs, traditional beadwork and enormous silk-framed mesh windows. In the main tent, there is a lounge, library and dining area

NEED *to know*

Items to remember to bring for your safari to Tanzania

- October - April: Casual summer clothes (shorts and cool shirts) and a warm jersey/sweater for the cooler morning and evening temperatures
- May - September: Casual light clothing and a very warm parka/jacket for the very cold mornings and nights
- Cotton clothing in neutral colours is recommended for game drives and compulsory for walks. Keep whites to a minimum, as white attracts certain bugs at night
- Comfortable walking shoes, track shoes or boots for bush walks and sandals to wear at meals and within the lodge area
- Formal attire is not required
- Swimming costumes/bathing suits
- Sun block/sun hat/sunglasses/lip balm
- Camera and spare memory cards
- Video camera and a spare battery

Geography and location

Singita Grumeti Reserves is located in northern Tanzania and forms part of the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem. The Singita Grumeti Reserves concession spans a vast 350 000 acres (140 000 hectares) of relatively untouched wilderness. The reserve is home to varying habitats including open plains, rugged rocky outcrops, woodlands and riverine forests.

Activities

- Game drives with professional guides
- Archery, lawn croquet, badminton, star-gazing safaris, swimming pools, horseback safaris and mountain biking are all available
- There are tennis courts at Sabora Tented Camp and Sasakwa Lodge with a choice of surfaces
- Spa & gym facilities are available at all three lodges
- Singita Shop
- Wireless internet access and satellite television at all three lodges

Private Land Rovers

All our safaris are conducted in Land Rovers with a maximum of six guests per vehicle. However, should you want complete privacy it is possible to hire a vehicle on a private basis. Sole use of Land Rovers will need to be reserved well in advance. Prices available on request.

NEED *to know*

Getting there

- Daily scheduled flights are available from Arusha, Kilimanjaro and Nairobi
- Flying time from Kilimanjaro International Airport is 1.5 hours
- Flying time from Arusha Airport is 1.15 hours
- All flights land at Sasakwa airstrip, located a few minutes from Sasakwa Lodge
- Private charters can be arranged
- Road transfer from Arusha is approximately 9.5 hours

Converters are available at each lodge.

Health requirements

Please ensure you consult your doctor before travelling to East Africa. Yellow Fever inoculations are compulsory when entering East Africa. Singita Grumeti Reserves is a malarial zone so it is essential to ensure that appropriate prophylactics be taken throughout the year.

Tariffs

Tariffs include:

- Luxurious all-suite accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner daily, teas and coffees
- Two open Land Rover safaris per day accompanied by an experienced guide, mountain biking, walking, tennis and archery
- Laundry and valet services
- All drinks, including premium wines, spirits and liqueurs (excluding vintage champagne and vintage wines on the connoisseurs wine list)

- Air transfers to and from the camp
- Spa treatments
